Gold Museum

Descriptions

The Gold Museum is located in the mountainous town of Jingua Rock in Ruifang Township, New Taipei City. With plenty of historical, humanities and natural heritage, the park is the first ecology museum in Taiwan. It lays special emphasis on heritage preservation, sustainable development; old buildings reuse as well as localized operations aimed at promoting regional development.

Chiufen

The villages of Chiufen were once centers of gold mining in Taiwan. The gold is gone, but these quaint old villages, built of closely-packed houses clinging to steep mountainsides, continue to offer enchanting scenery and fascinating glimpses into the lifestyles of the past.

Chiufen Old Street walking tour

Chiufen Old Street is one of the representative old streets in Taipei; it is also one of the busiest and most commercial streets in the region, it being a narrow winding street that is barely 3m wide. The name “Chiufen” means “next to Keelung Mountain” – the street hugs the mountain from the Old Street Entry by the foot of Keelung Mountain, meandering across Daganling until it hits Qingbian Road. The street totals 850m in length and were known as the “Dark Street”.
